

1. Title of the practice: Organizing Teacher Training Programme , Seminars & Conferences

2. The context that required the initiation of the practice:

Research is a continuous and very important component of academic life, but in view of the paucity of time the teachers & students rarely find an opportunity to venture into the field of research as there are very few opportunities in the vicinity under the given circumstances. In order to encourage & thus provide a platform to the researchers to present & discuss their work , the institution has continuously provided opportunities the young scholars & researchers through organization of conferences & seminars on a regular basis.

3. Objectives of the practice:

The major objective , keeping in view the context was to inculcate the research aptitude amongst the teachers & students by providing them exposure thus adding to the depth of their knowledge & experience through interactions with researchers from across the country.

4. The Practice:

The college has developed & followed a routine programme for organizing seminars & conferences to provide a suitable platform to the students & teachers who not only are engaged in organising these events but also have actively participated in these seminars from time to time. Thus providing them an exposure to the important field of research & enquiry. The College organized a national seminar on 'Sindh – A cultural Legacy' in collaboration with the National Council for Promotion of Sindhi Language in which a large number of participants participated . A national conference on 'Changing Dynamics of Cultural Economy in Western Himalyas' to dwell upon the important aspects of cultural economy in the western Himalyas was also organized with enthusiastic participation by various faculty members . This conference presented opportunities to the students to listen to some of the most prominent speakers on the topic thereby bringing in them a perceptible change in their attitude to approach literature from a researcher's point of view. These seminars & conferences not only provided an opportunity to the faculty members but also presented a wonderful platform to many form the neighbouring colleges as many of them participated & interacted with researchers of national & international. A Five day Teacher training Programme aimed at providing training & necessary orientation to teachers was also organized in collaboration with Teaching Learning Center (TLC) National Institute of Technical Teacher's Training & Research, Shamla Hills Bhopal.

5. Obstacles faced if any and strategies adopted to overcome them:

Problems of ephemeral nature can be overcome with right kind of motivation, guidance & encouragement. The practice followed with the right intent & focus has made significant changes in the outlook & behaviour towards enquiry & research.
