

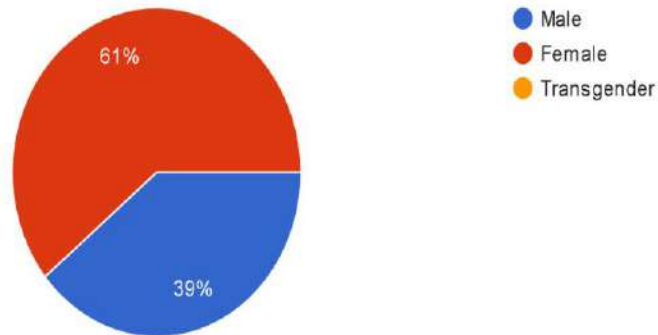
I. Students Feedback

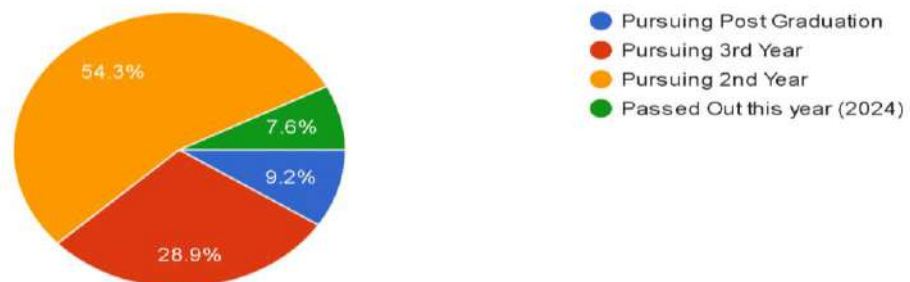


In Figure 1.1 it is showed that the majority of respondents are Males, 61% and 39% are Females.

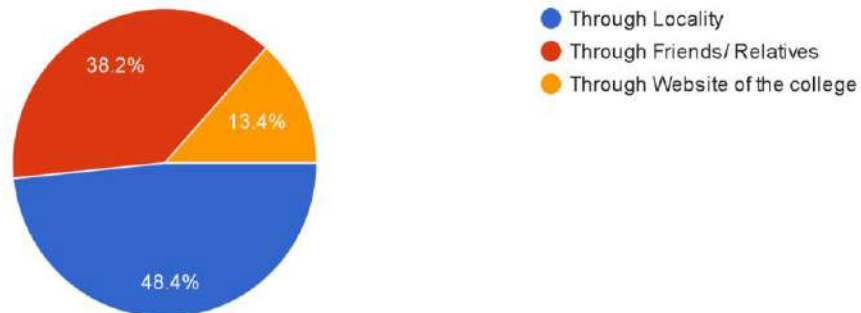

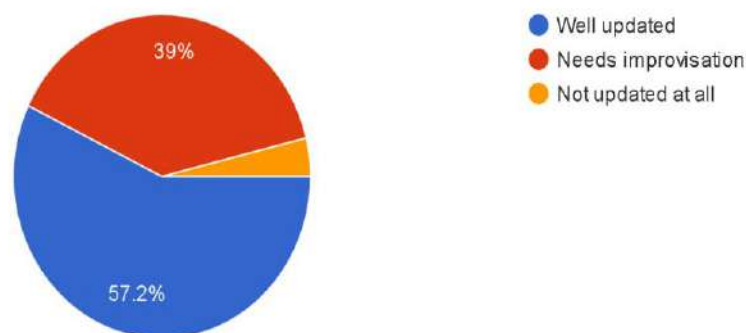
In Figure 1.3 it is showed that the respondents came to know about the college; 48% through locality, 38.2% through friends/relatives and 13.4% through website of the college.

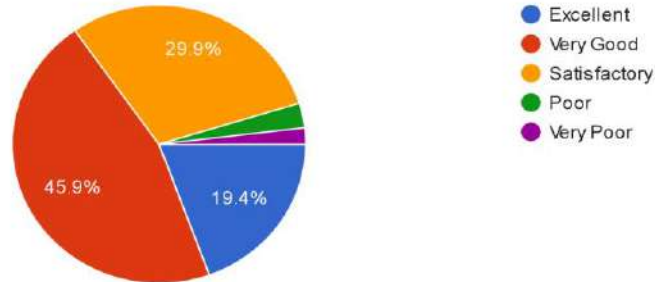
In Figure 1.4 it is showed that the majority of respondents said about the website of the college is 57.2% well updated, 39% needs improvisation and 3.8% not updated at all.

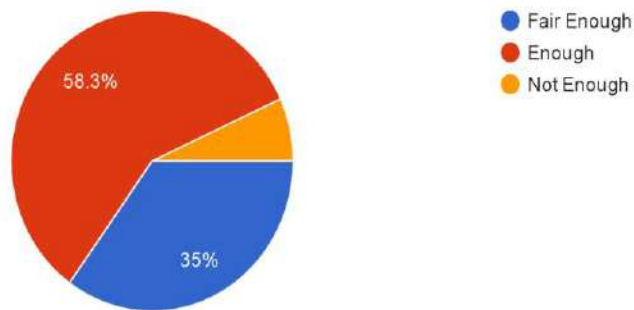

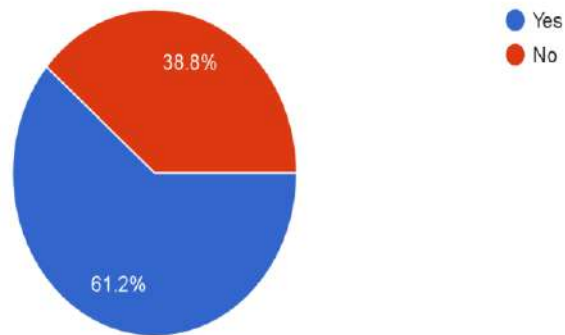
In Figure 1.6 it is showed that the responses of the respondents regarding the class rooms in the college are 58.3% enough, 35% fair enough and 6.7% not enough.

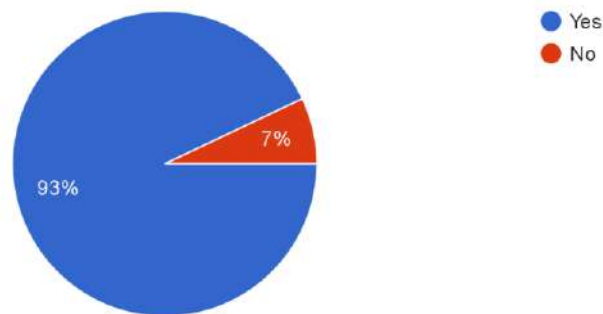
In Figure 1.7 it is showed that regarding the availability of the girl's common room facility in the college as 61.2% said yes and 38.8 said no.

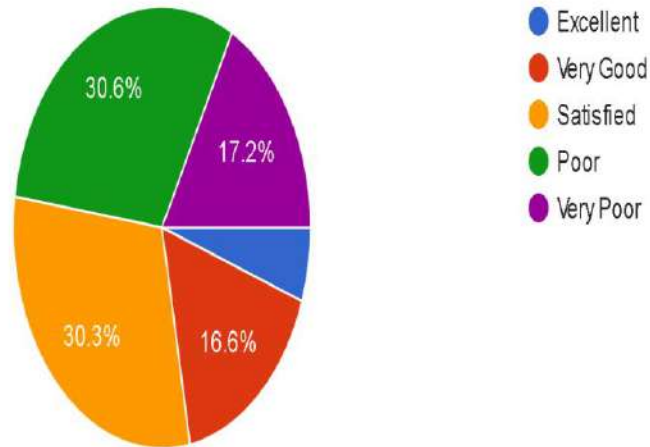
In Figure 1.8 it is showed that regarding the availability of separate washroom facility for boys and girls in the college as 93% said yes and 7% said no.

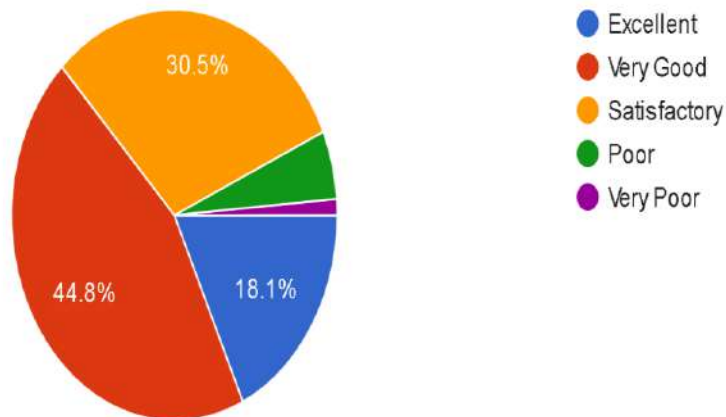

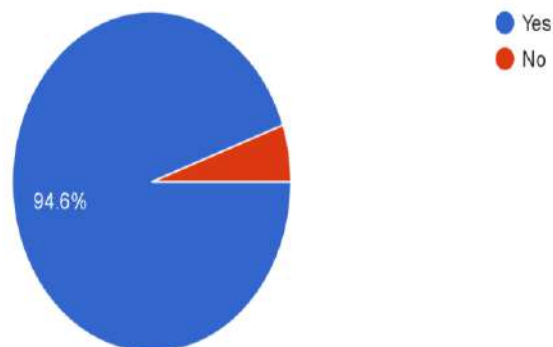

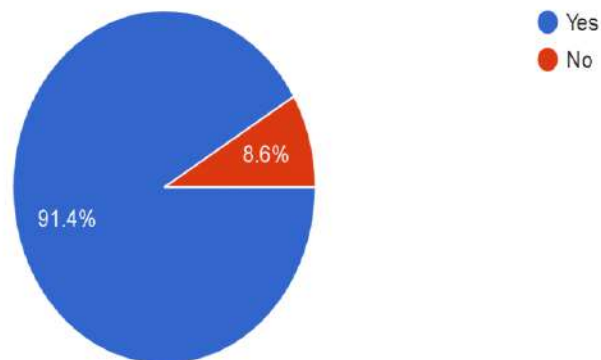
In Figure 1.11 it is showed that the responses regarding the availability of smart class room's facilities in the college are as 94.6% said yes and 5.4% said no.

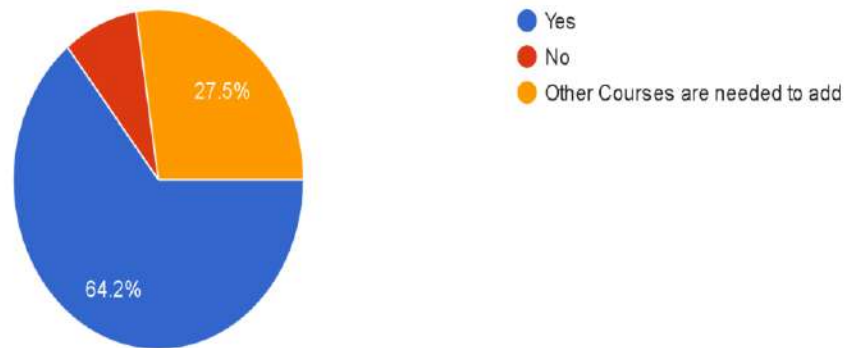
In Figure 1.12 it is showed that the responses regarding the use of smart class room's facilities by the class teachers are as 91.4% said yes and 8.6% said no.

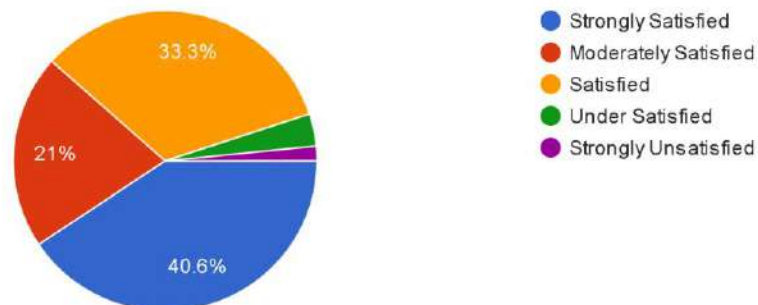

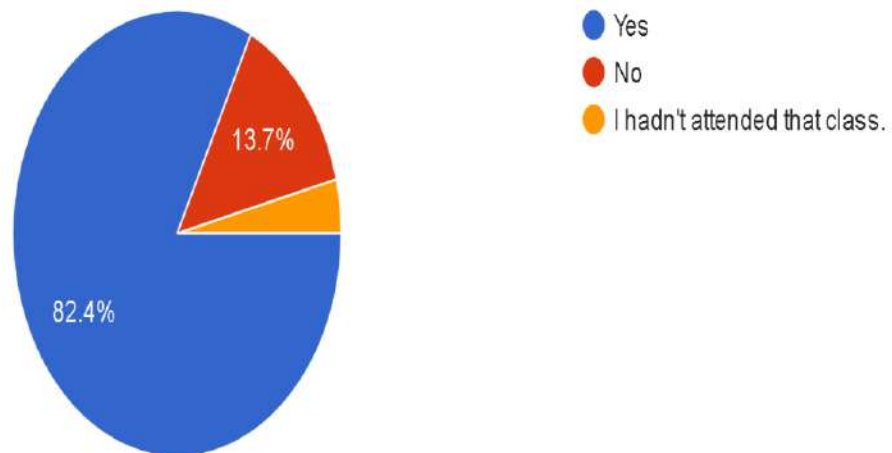

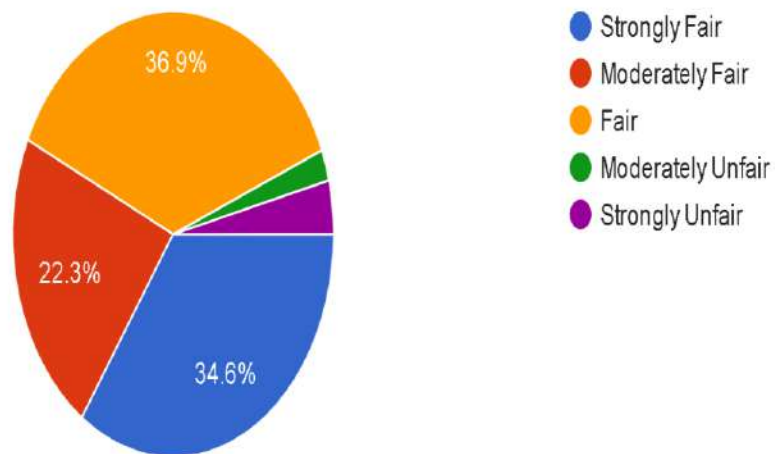

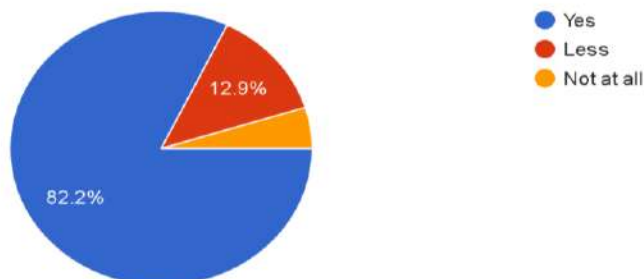

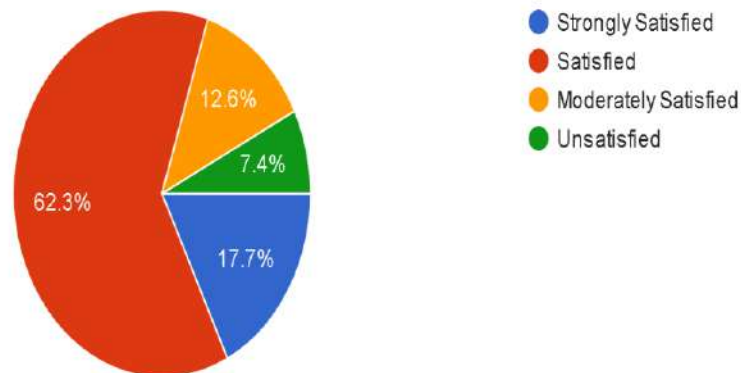

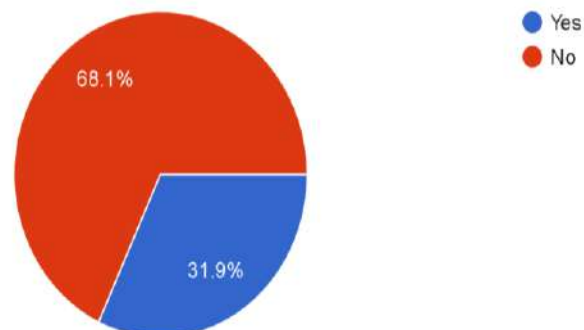

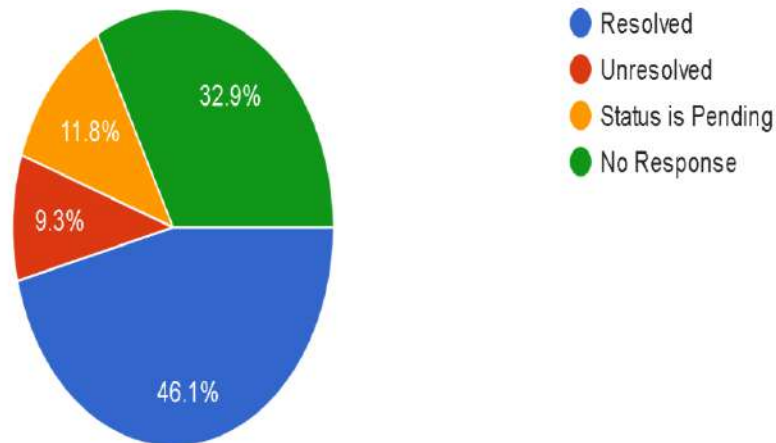

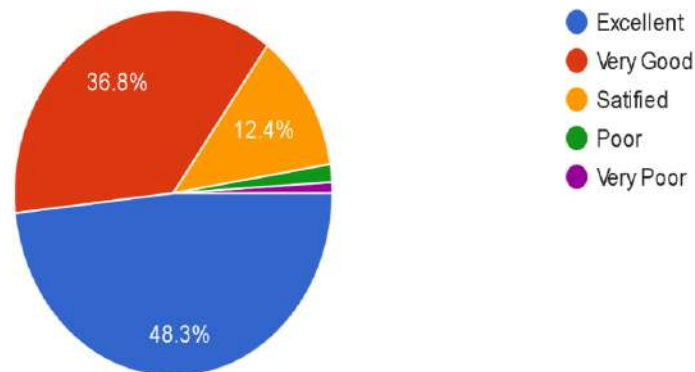

Final Conclusion
